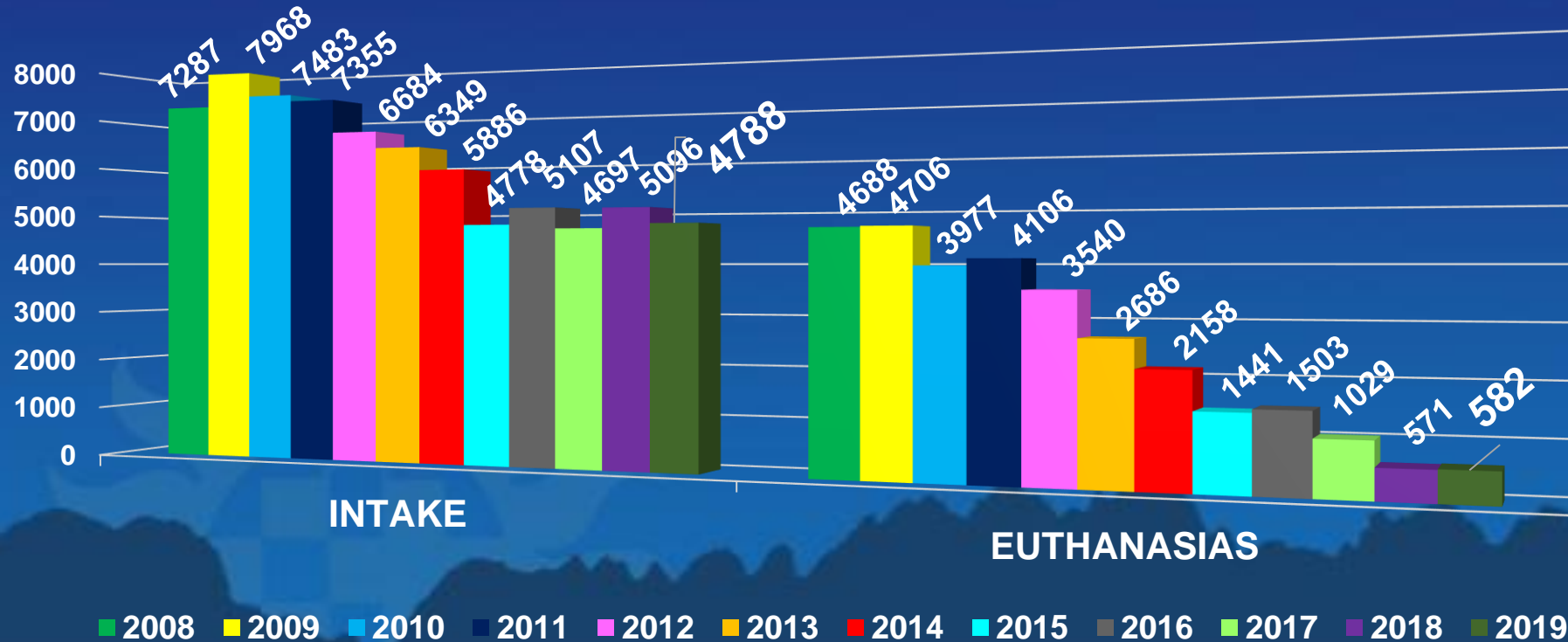

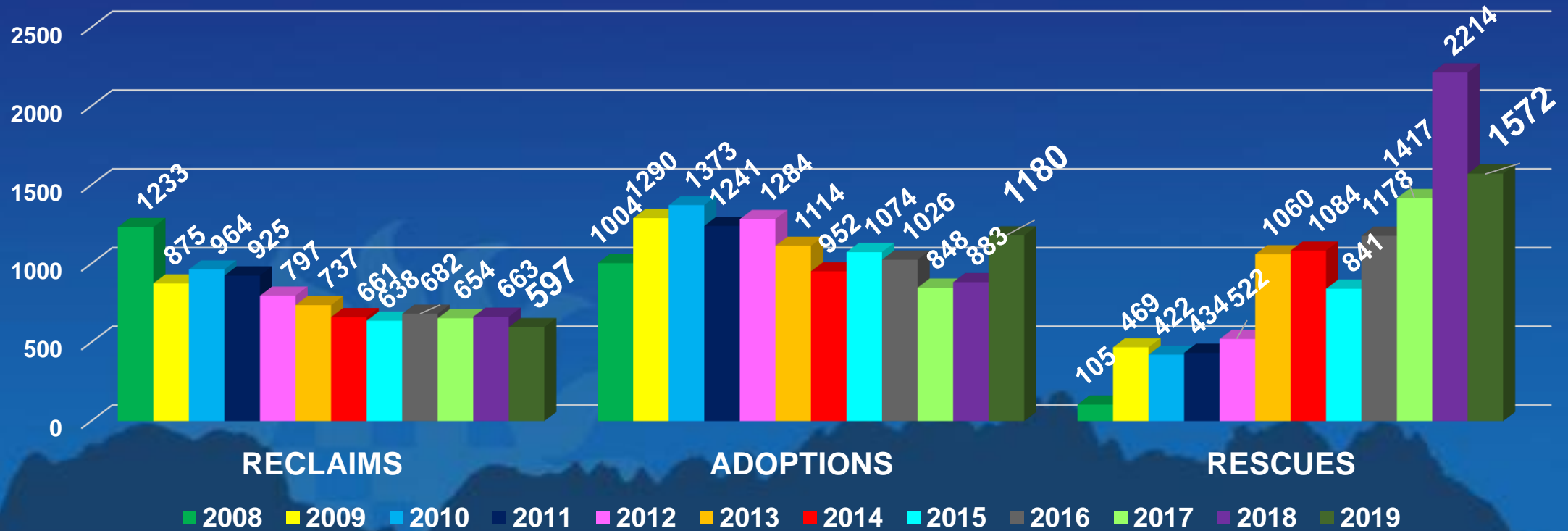

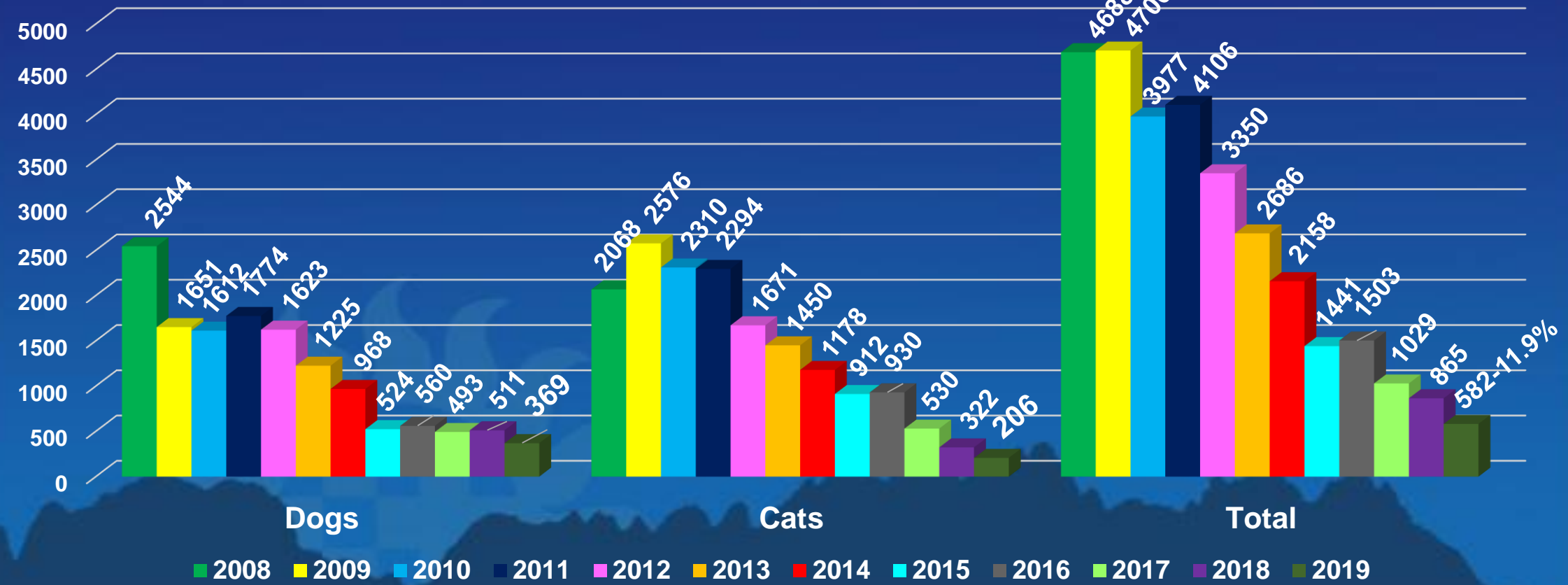
January - June Statistical Comparison: 2008-2019



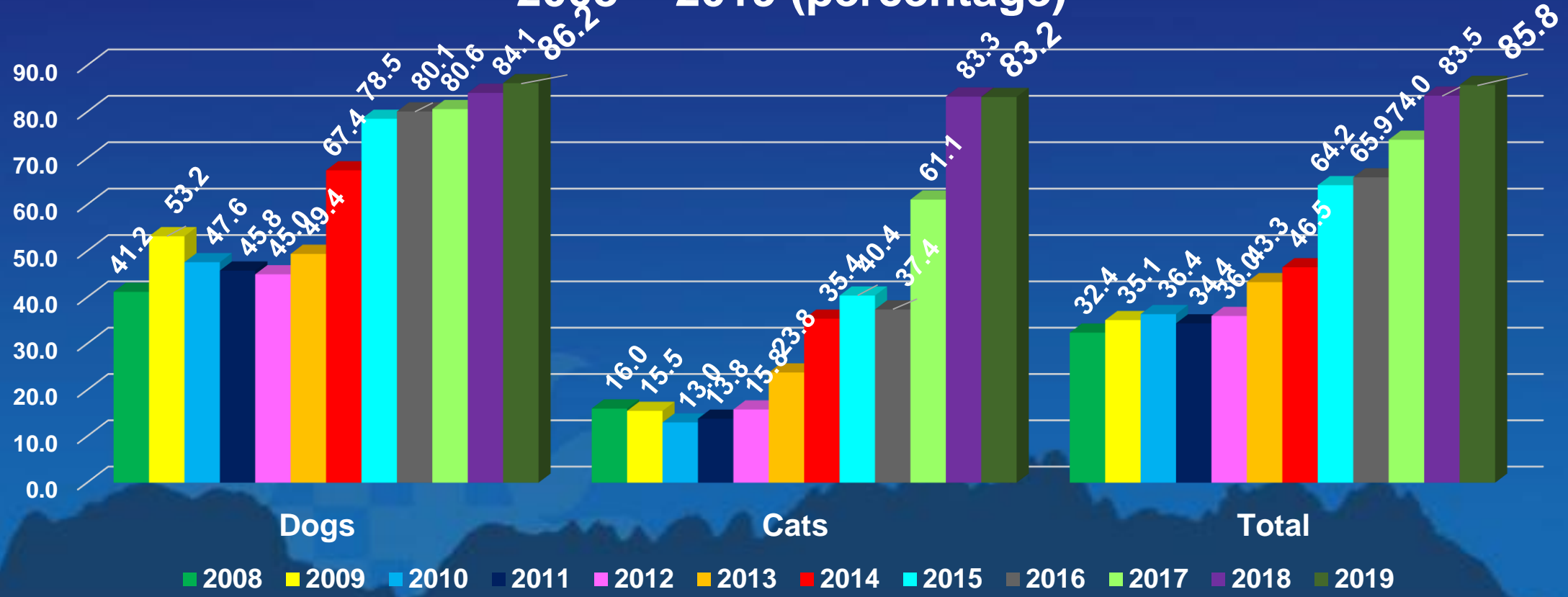
January - June Statistical Comparison: 2008-2019



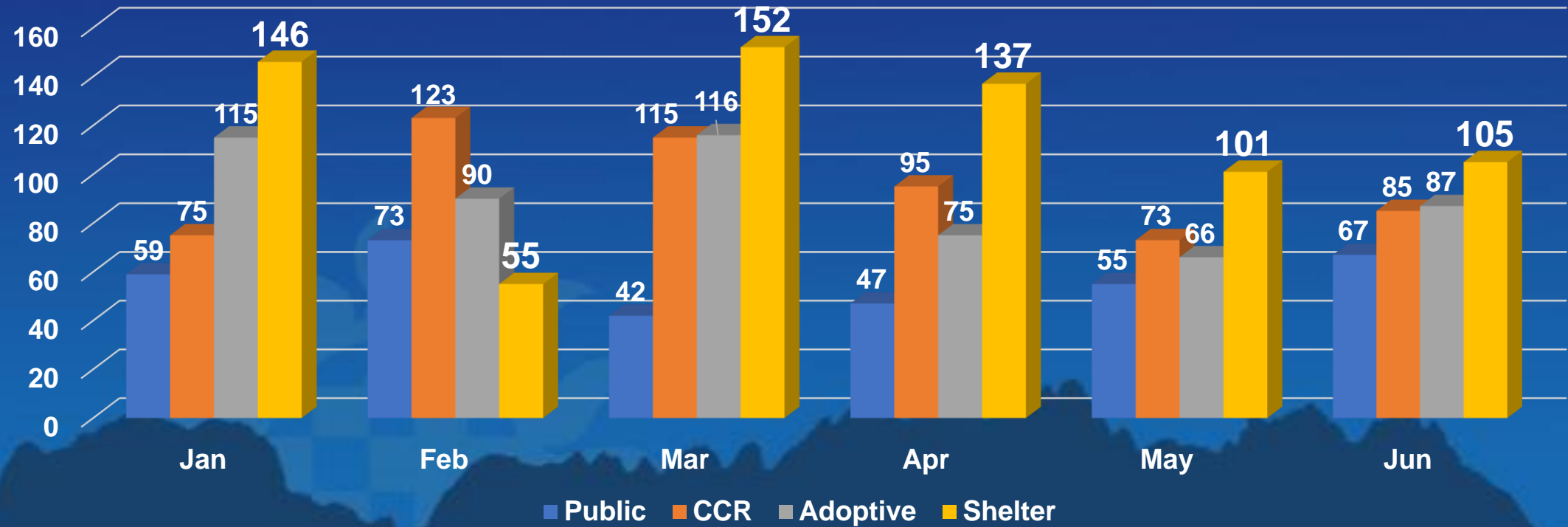
January - June Euthanasia Comparison for 2008 -- 2019
